

Public Notice 19-09-C-00-SCK Passenger Facility Charge Use Application
Stockton Metropolitan Airport

The County of San Joaquin ("County") intends to file a Notice of Intent to use Passenger Facility Charges ("PFC") to fund future projects at Stockton Metropolitan Airport ("Airport").

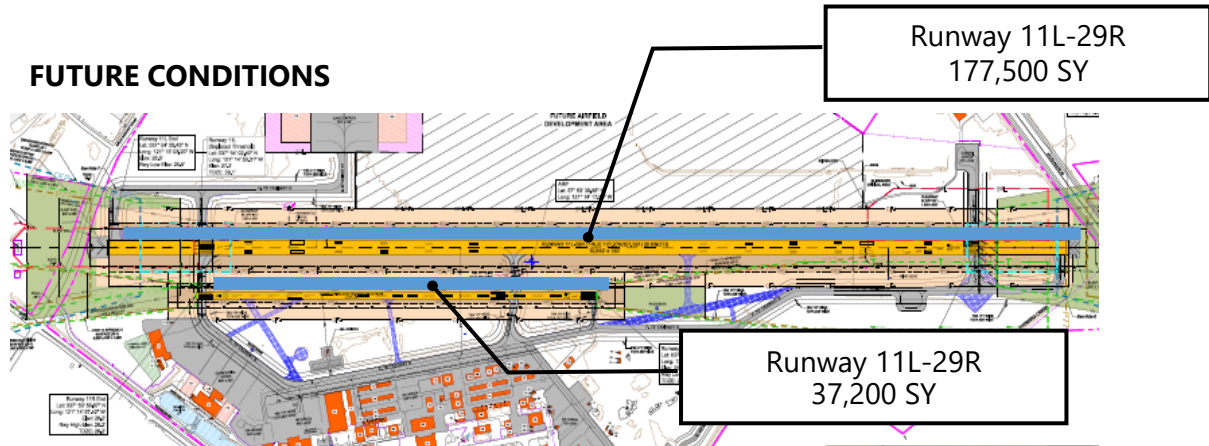
The notice complies with the requirement in Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 158.24 that the Airport provide written notice to the public and an opportunity for public comment before filing a PFC use application with the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA").

The County of San Joaquin will file a Notice of Intent with the FAA to request authority to use the already collected PFC amount of \$89,300 that was previously authorized for impose only for **Project 06 – Runway 11L/29R & Runway 11R/29L Rehabilitation** in PFC Application 19-09-C-00-SCK.

1. Project Description and Justification

Project: Runway 11L-29R & Runway 11R-29L Rehabilitation (Local Share)

Description: This project includes environmental documentation, design, and construction to rehabilitate (crack seal & slurry coat) Runway 11L-29R (~177,500 sy) and Runway 11R-29L (~37,200 sy) per the 2016 Pavement Maintenance and Management Plan.



Justification: The project is needed to maintain the pavement in good working order. The pavement rehabilitation will provide for a full functional runway with extended useful life.

Level of Collection: \$4.50

Project Type: Use

PFC Use Amount Requested: \$89,300

Project Schedule:

Environmental: CATEX, December 2018 through July 2019

Design: January 2019 through April 2019

Project Bidding and Contract Award: April 2019 through June 2019

Construction: Summer 2020

AIP Grant Number: Grant 41 (FY2019)

Project Funding Plan: The local share of the total project cost is funded with PFCs on a pay-as-you-go-basis:
